You find oceans near beaches. There are seven oceans. The Atlantic Ocean, the Pacific Ocean, the Indian Ocean, and the Arctic ocean.

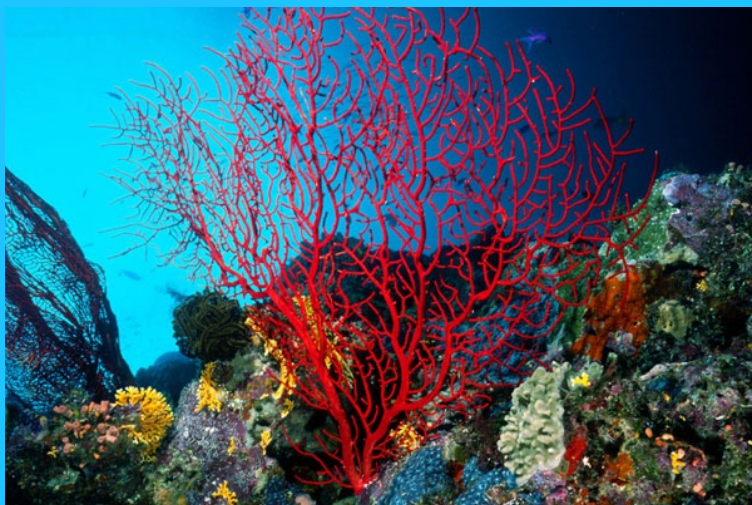

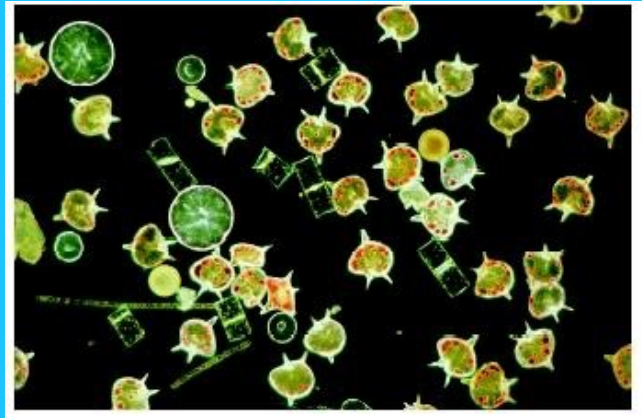




Animals and plants all live in the ocean. Plants called coral live in the ocean. Coral is really colourful and fish live in it.



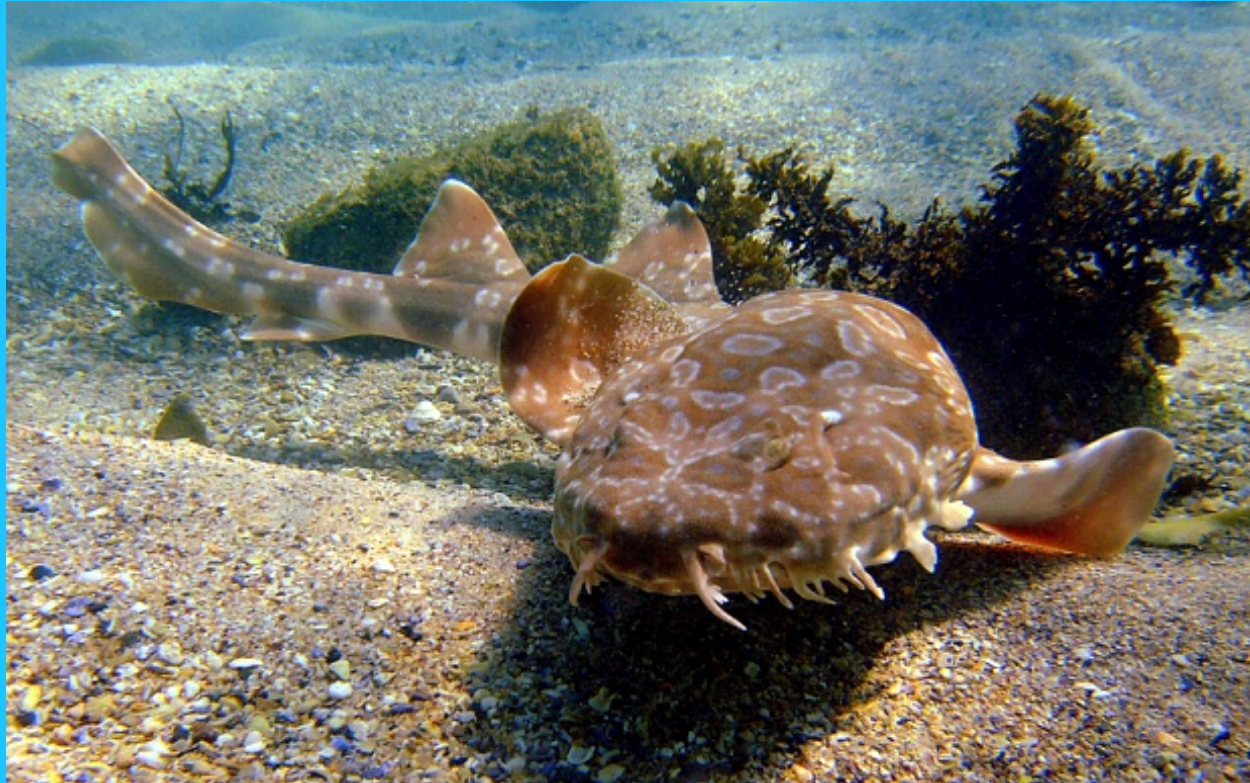
Chomp!

People need to learn to respect the ocean and let animals survive.

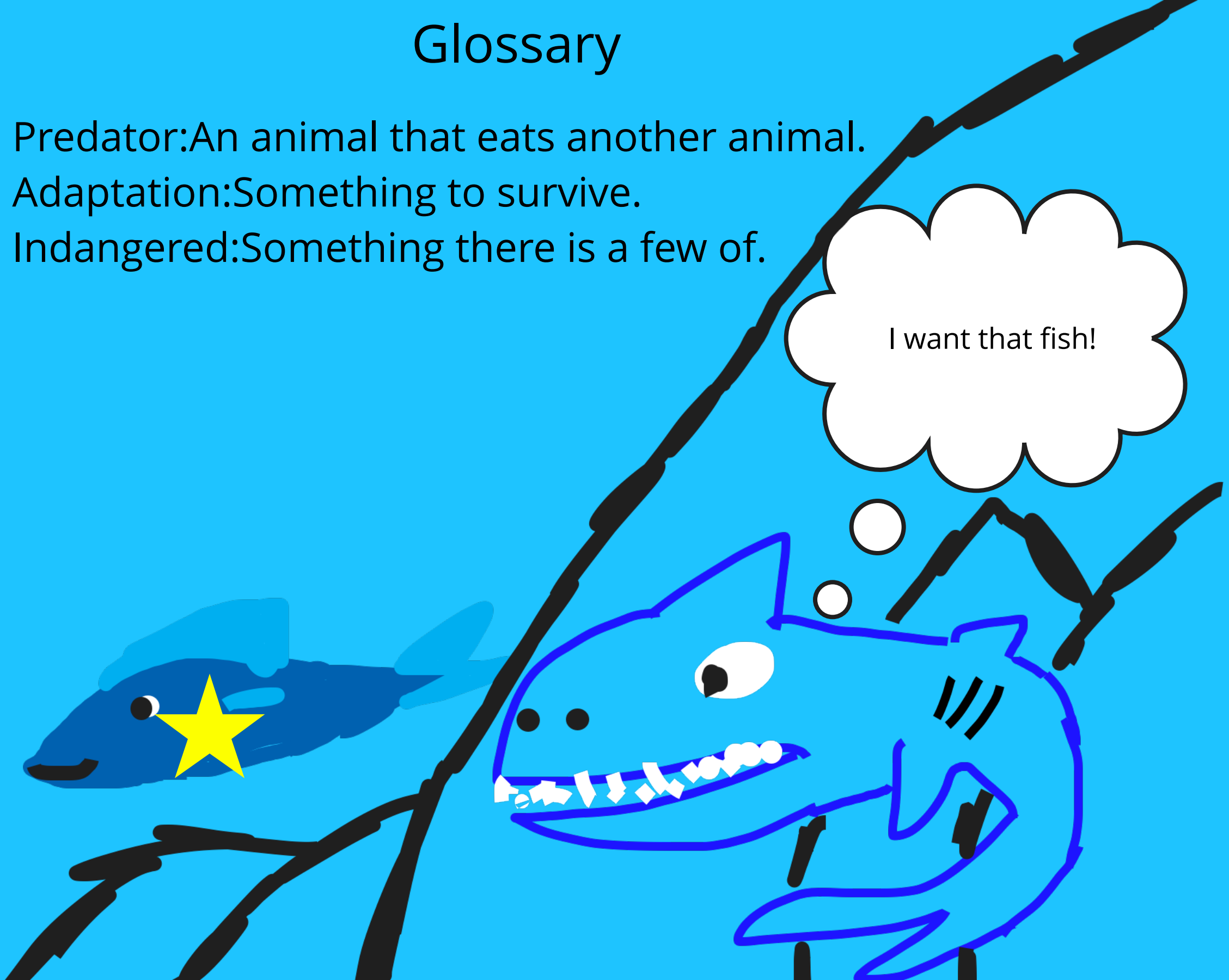

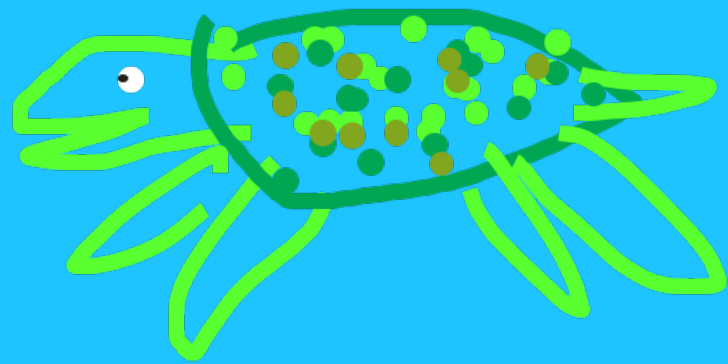
